Most of the signatures are stitched in pale blue on the white cloth. A few are in dark red. These have been rendered in red on this list, though we do not know a reason for the different colour. Four names appear on a square in the centre of the cloth; these have been rendered here in blue. Two or three male names appear on the cloth. Did the Louise Young admit men, or are these perhaps young sons of members who were dragged along to so many meetings they became honorary members? We are referring to John and Thomas Light, as well as possibly Bryce Morrow. Also note that "Sue Joyce" is the Minister's wife.
